Any subsequent revisions applicable to Canadian registered aircraft must be approved by Transport Canada. In addition the following requirements apply:

- a. Miscellaneous Markings and Placards ref. 523.1557(c)(3);
- b. Aeroplane Flight Manual ref. 523.1581(f)(g).

Canadian Configuration

The Canadian configuration is defined in Cessna Drawing Number 0500530 [Airplane Assy - Model 172] (including Drawing No. 0501139) at Revision B or later FAA approved revision.

Import Requirements

The import documentation must include:

- a) A United States Export Certificate of Airworthiness to Canada signed by a representative of the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA)

or

- b) A Certificate of Airworthiness for Export signed by the Airworthiness Authority of a country with whom Canada has a Bilateral Airworthiness agreement.

In case a) or b) the C of A must contain the following statement:

"The aircraft identified by this Certificate has been examined and found to conform to the Canadian Department of Transport Aircraft Type Certificate A-199"

or

c) Other procedures approved by the Minister of Transport.


Approved Publications

1. Cessna Model 172R Pilot's Operating Handbook and FAA Approved Airplane Flight Manual including Revision 1 dated 28 February 1997 (Part Number 172RPHUS01) or later approved revision and including Supplement 12, Canadian Supplement.

NOTE 1

Canadian Type Certificate A-199 is applicable to the model 172R only. Those other Cessna Aircraft Company aircraft models listed under FAA Type Certificate 3A12 which have been approved for operation in Canada at an earlier date, may be acceptable under FAA Type Certificate 3A12.
