

Night Rating

Course Description

The Night Rating allows an individual to fly a single engine aircraft at night between the hours of civil sunset and civil twilight. The night rating is a perfect continuation of your Private Pilot training, creating enhanced situational awareness and better airmanship.

Take-off just before sunset and watch the warm glow over the horizon as you cruise along on an evening flight!

- 17 Years of Age
- Category 1 or 3 Medical
- Private Pilot License (PPL)

Minimum License Requirements

- 20 Hours of Flight Time
 - 10 Hours Night Training
 - 5 Dual Hours
 - 5 Solo Hours
 - 10 Hours Instrument Training
- Written Exams
 - N/A
